INVITATION TO BID

STRASBURG BOROUGH AUTHORITY will receive sealed proposals online via PennBid for the CLOVER AVE SEWER MAIN AND SUSAN AVE INTERCEPTOR REPLACEMENT project in accordance with the Contract Documents. Sealed bids may be submitted and updated online via the PennBid Program until 10:00 A.M., prevailing time, July 18, 2018. Bids will be opened and read aloud shortly thereafter at the Strasburg Borough Authority, 145 Precision Ave, Strasburg, PA 17579, Lancaster County.

The work for the Clover Avenue Sewer Main replacement generally includes installation of approximately 1,400 linear feet of 10" PVC piping, 30 linear feet of 8" PVC piping, 6 manholes, 81 linear feet of 18" steel casing for boring under a pond, as shown in the Drawings and described in the Contract Documents.

The work for the Susan Avenue Interceptor Replacement generally includes removal of approximately 125 linear feet of an existing 8" PVC Sewer line, installation of approximately 505 linear feet of 12" PVC piping, 4 watertight manholes, 53 linear feet of concrete, and the necessary techniques open cut through a stream and section of wetlands, as shown in the Drawings and described in the Contract Documents. Both projects are in Strasburg Borough, Lancaster County.
