Call to Order and Pledge to the Flag: The meeting was held at the Strasburg Borough Municipal Offices, 145 Precision Avenue, Strasburg PA and was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Vice Chairman Len Ferber, followed by the salute to the flag. Vice Chairman Ferber announced that the meeting is being audiotaped and maintained until the minutes are approved and that recommendations from tonight’s meeting will be considered at the March 10, 2026 Council meeting.

Consider a motion to approve the minutes of February 3, 2026: A motion was made by Pete Kingsley, seconded by Lori Troiano, and passed unanimously to approve the minutes of the February 3, 2026 meeting as printed.

Consider a motion regarding the application for 51 East Main Street for front porch posts: Dave DiFranco, owner of 51 East Main Street, was in attendance and reviewed his application to replace his front porch posts with 6” colonial style Perma Posts. The members were reminded that the porch posts were previously discussed at the November 4, 2025 meeting and the Perma Posts were one of the possible replacements suggested by HARB.

Pete Kingsley made a motion, seconded by Eldon Stoltzfus and passed unanimously to recommend Borough Council approve the replacement of the porch posts as submitted for Dave DiFranco, owner of 51 East Main Street, which is in accordance with the Secretary of the Interior’s Standards for Rehabilitation Standard 36 CFR 67 Standard Number 9.

Other Business: Len Ferber announced that Steve VanOrmer has submitted his resignation from HARB. Members expressed their thanks to Steve VanOrmer for his over 50 years of service. Borough Council is seeking applicants to fill the two vacancies which are both for property owners who reside in the district.
